- Depending on the area of assistance, may need to attend separate meetings and/or conference calls with chair and volunteers.
- Check emails frequently for rodeo updates.
- Leading up to the rodeo, additional meetings and/or time may be needed.
- Get input from their peers and neighbors and find out what they like and what they would like to see. Give a voice from the youth.
- Learn about the rodeo.
- Keep communication with their Youth Leader(s) and the chair that they will be assisting.
- Rodeo weekend will be work.....they may not see the rodeo, they may not have time for their friends or family, but they will have been part of a great rodeo committee.

Being part of this committee will be fun, exciting and a lot of work for some.
