 - 3% on credit card (in place of credit card fees). We get .5% back. Took out the middleman. They process the credit cards.
 - Refund on site back to the customer
 - We control the reporting Real time reporting
 - o Can use for other events Fees are per event.
 - Needs a minimum of 10 tablets.
 - Replacement of tablets is approximately \$300.00
 - Internet connection may be an issue
 - o ID checks for alcohol wristband with RFID in it
 - Do not have initial ID check capability
